Exeter has a great choice of conference and event venues, with large, purpose-built venues that can host up to 5,000 people, such as Westpoint Arena, and sporting venues such as Sandy Park – home to the Exeter Chiefs rugby team, and Exeter Racecourse, where you can hold your event with panoramic views of the UK's highest racecourse. Exeter Golf & Country Club offers event space in a Georgian manor house overlooking the 18-hole golf course.

Event Exeter has some great spaces across 250 acres of the University of Exeter's campus, with meeting, seminar, function and exhibition rooms, and lecture theatres able to accommodate up to 1,400 people, and over 1,000 bedrooms available for residential conferences. The city's hotels can offer deluxe space for residential events, from the large Mercure Southgate and Rougemont Hotels to boutique hotels such as the City Gate Hotel or Southernhay House situated in Exeter's leafy business quarter.









Exeter has some unique and exciting spaces — and with a 2,000 year long history it's no surprise there are plenty of historic venues in which to inspire your delegates. Hold a hosted dinner in the nave of the magnificent Exeter Cathedral, amongst ancient artefacts at RAMM, or at Powderham Castle, the 600 year old family home of the Earl and Countess of Devon.

Set sail on the Exe Estuary or out to sea, with an event aboard a Stuart Line Cruise, or on a floating barge in the middle of the Estuary at the River Exe Café. Not far from the sea, the Kitchen at the Donkey Sanctuary provides a tranquil atmosphere, with views out to the donkeys and the rolling Devon hills.

Mix business with pleasure with an event at Crealy, giving you free access to one of Devon's top theme parks. With arguably the best part of Devon on Exeter's doorstep – Dartmoor National Park lies to the west and the World Heritage Jurassic Coast and two Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty stretch to the east – this is the ultimate natural playground for outdoor activities and teambuilding.

Allow your team to thrive together, build communication and problem solving skills – whilst getting muddy! – at the Bear Trail, or for something a little drier, take part in an Apprentice–style challenge, or competitive cooking at the Exeter Cookery School.

Exeter is renowned for its excellent quality food and drink, with outlying farmland and vineyards providing the freshest produce in many of the city's cafes and restaurants. Why not incorporate a vineyard or brewery tour and tasting within your corporate event.

Mix business with the excitement of match day at Exeter Chiefs, with pitch-view hospitality and a pre-match Q&A with the players.






Take a break from work to explore this beautiful part of England.
