

Hoopern Valley Walk

Part of Exeter's Green Circle

Length: ~2 Miles

Duration: 45 minutes

THE EXETER GREEN CIRCLE

The Exeter Green Circle is a twelve-mile walk around the outskirts of Exeter – from green countryside valley parks to the pavements of quiet leafy suburbs.

The walk has five sections as shown on the full route map below.



Exeter's green gateway

This part of the Green Circle winds close to the City Wall and through the centre of St David's revealing the now dry valley under the Iron Bridge.

Elsewhere it follows parts of the picturesque Hoopern Valley through the University of Exeter's Streatham campus with its arboretum. Near the high point of the route, there are views to the sea in one direction and Dartmoor in another over Duryard Valley Park.
