Day 1:

9.30am

Day 1:



12noon

Watch one of the great live sports on offer in Exeter!

4pm

Take a tour of the Exeter Brewery to see local ales brewed before sampling them. Tours begin in the Tap Room for drinks, followed by the Brewery Tour itself, which lasts approximately 40 minutes and then back to the Tap for pie, mash peas & gravy and more beers.

Day 1:



6.30pm

Delve into immersive, narrative driven stories at Red House Mysteries escape rooms. You will have to try finding clues and solving puzzles so that you can escape!

8pm

Head out on the town! Start at the Oddfellows or Old Firehouse for some local ales, then take your pick of Exeter's nightlife, from the rooftop hotspots at Queen St Dining, to underground live music at the Exeter Cavern, there is something for everyone!



Day Two:



9am

Start the day with brunch at Las Iguanas, and if you can face it, go bottomless with unlimited prosecco or draught beer!

11am

If you stayed off the beers at brunch, make your way over to the Quay Climbing Centre to scale the south west's largest indoor climbing wall!

12noon

Enjoy a dustbin-lid pizza for lunch, at the renowned 'On the Waterfront' restaurant.

Day 2:



2pm

Hire a paddleboard or kayak from AS Watersports; Saddles and Paddles or Haven Banks Outdoor Education Centre, to test your balance as you navigate your way down the river or canal – see if you can make it all the way to the Double Locks pub for a quick drinks stop!

Day 2:



6pm

Visit one of the eclectic choices of restaurants around Exeter for dinner. Southernhay House Hotel offer a cocktail masterclass, which you can try your hand at either before or after dinner!

8pm

Check out one of the many theatre productions or comedy nights Exeter has to offer – we have the Exeter Northcott Theatre; the Barnfield Theatre; the Cygnet Theatre; the Exeter Phoenix and the Exeter Corn Exchange.
